1. Beta agonist nebulizer/aerosolizer 5%
2. Buccal route 5%
3. Intramuscular (epinephrine & glucagon) 5%
4. Intranasal (naloxone) 5%
5. Intravenous (naloxone) 5%
6. Intravenous access 30%
7. Intravenous maintenance (IV fluids) 10%
8. Introduction to Team Leadership and Membership 10%
9. Nitrous oxide 5%
10. Pediatric Intraosseous access 10%
11. Supraglottic airways 5%
12. Tracheal bronchial suctioning (already intubated) 5%
