9. File a nail tip to blend into the natural nail
10. Apply a mixture of nail monomer and powder to the nail plate and free edge
11. File the acrylic nail to a natural look
12. Construct sculpture nails
13. Apply nail forms
14. Remove nail forms
15. Prepare the new growth of an artificial nail prior to a touch-up
16. Fill the new growth of an artificial nail
17. Apply nail gel over artificial nails
18. Apply nail gel over natural nails
19. Apply fiberglass fabric over artificial nails
20. Apply fiberglass fabric over natural nails
21. Remove artificial nail product from the natural nail
22. Remove excess artificial nail product from the skin
23. Perform nail silking
24. Apply nail lacquer smoothly over the entire nail plate and free edge
25. Use an electric file
26. Use UV lamps
27. Apply paraffin wax to the hands and feet
28. Remove paraffin wax from the hands and feet
29. Perform air brushing techniques with stencils and freehand
30. Perform nail art and design
